

Reverse Tuck



Style: Container
Closure: Glued
Die Cut? Yes
Common Flutes: E/Folding Carton

This style is called a "Reverse Tuck" due to its flaps that tuck into the top/bottom to close the carton. □
The flaps are reversed on the panel sequence so that when you are holding the product to open the top end, □
The bottom has a clean looking scored corner and the tuck flap is hidden on the back. □
This style is great for retail packaging small products and can be customized with built in inserts to hold oddly shaped products □
in the carton snugly so there is no movement.
