The HSC style is very similar to the RSC, the main difference being that flaps are only on the bottom end of the box. This leaves the top of the box open at all times, sometimes a tray is used as a removable lid to this carton. Typically, the longer major flaps meet in the middle to form the bottom. The manufacturer's joint is most often joined with adhesive but may also be taped or stitched. The box is shipped flat (knocked down) to the packager who sets up the box, fills it, and closes it for shipment. Box closure may be by tape, adhesive, staples, strapping, etc.
